Camp Basic Information

- Camp Gan Israel (CGI) opens on Monday, June 27th at 9:00 am and ends at 4:00pm on Friday, July 22nd.
- CGI will be held at Chabad JCC, 57 S. Williams Street, Burlington
- CGI begins each morning at 9:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm. Children may be dropped off at any time *after 8:45 am. (Early and Late Care are also available for an additional fee; please see the enclosed Registration and Camper Information Sheet for further details)*

What Your Child Should Bring

- A dairy or pareve lunch, plus a filling snack for the afternoon.
- A bottle of water on trip days
- A swim suit (labeled with your child's name) and a towel
- Sunscreen every day
- At least one penny per day. We will be teaching the children the great mitzvah of Tzedakah (Charity). Your child should bring at least one penny per day to be put in the Tzedakah box.
- CGI T-shirt on trip days. Beautiful CGI T-shirts will be available for \$10.00. It is very important for all the children to wear these T-shirts on trip days.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE that any personal belongings your child brings to CGI are *clearly labeled* with his or her name.

Additional Information

- Mountain Transit buses (with seat belts) and their drivers will be used for trips. If you wish, you may leave your child's car seat (labeled with their name) with us, if you would like it to be used on the bus trips. *Occasionally, if the group is small, the children will be transported in a van by a responsible driver. Car seats can be used here as well.*
- If you are in need of transportation to or from Camp Gan Israel, please notify us as soon as possible.
- A weekly CGI Newsletter will be sent during the camp season to inform you of any particulars for that specific week.
